Duties and Responsibilities

Essential Duties and Tasks:

- Operates a patrol car or walks to detect: violations of traffic laws, suspicious persons or activities, and disturbances of law and order
- Responds to radio dispatches, answers calls and complaints, serves warrants and make arrests
- Testifies in court, investigates traffic accidents, provides police escorts, directs traffic and reports unsafe conditions existing in streets or other facilities
- Assists with criminal investigation by presenting evidence, interviewing victims and witnesses and preparing detailed reports
- Works an assigned shift

Recruitment and Selection Guidelines

Minimum Qualifications:

- Be a United States Citizens
- Minimum 21 years of age
- Must not have been convicted of a felony or serious misdemeanor
- Must possess a valid North Carolina Driver's License with a Good Driving Record
- Vision corrected to 20/20 and not colorblind
- Must possess a high school diploma or GED, college degree preferred
- Basic Law Enforcement Training Certification is required
